SUBJECT: AOPP 1.5 -- ACADEMIC INTEGRITY: HONOR CODE

PURPOSE: The Honor Code is an essential way to reach the College's goals of academic excellence, personal growth for each student, and a community life based on high moral standards, trust, and mutual respect. Simply stated, the Honor Code is the belief that the students of Young Harris College should commit themselves to nothing less than the rigorous adherence to intellectual honesty in all facets of academic life, including the writing of papers and laboratory reports, quizzes, homework assignments, examinations, and all documents submitted to the College. At its heart, the Honor Code asks each member of the College community to be a person of integrity.

REVIEW: This AOPP will be reviewed every four years (or whenever circumstances require an earlier review) by the Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs (AVPAA) with recommendations for revision presented to Academic Council and the Vice President for Academic Affairs. Any change(s) to this AOPP as a result of review will be effective the subsequent fall semester.
