SUBJECT: AOPP 3.36 – Institutional Compliance with SACSCOC Policies

PURPOSE: The purpose of this policy is to establish the responsibility for the College's compliance with SACSCOC policies.

REVIEW: This AOPP will be reviewed every four years (or whenever circumstances require an earlier review) by the Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs (AVPAA) with recommendations for revision presented to Academic Council and the Vice President for Academic Affairs. Any change to this AOPP as a result of review will be effective the subsequent fall semester.

POLICY/PROCEDURE: As an accredited institutional member of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), Young Harris College must comply with all SACSCOC policies. Young Harris College's SACSCOC Accreditation Liaison is responsible for keeping abreast of SACSCOC policies and ensuring compliance with accreditation requirements. The Accreditation Liaison is appointed by and reports directly to the President for all matters of SACSCOC accreditation.
