Service on the Council is a challenging and satisfying way for students to gain transferable leadership skills in critical and reflective thinking, civility, communication, and deductive reasoning. Students selected to serve on the Student Conduct Council will have the opportunity to influence the way students perceive the student conduct process, as well as influence the campus culture by upholding student rights and established YHC community standards.

Duties of Student Conduct Council Members:

- Educate students concerning relevant college policies and procedures
- Arrive at an accurate and impartial decision by carefully reviewing each incident, as well as individual student involvement
- Afford each student involved a chance to respond to the alleged violation(s)
- Hold those students found to be in violation of college policy accountable by imposing appropriate sanctions

Qualifications:

- Current, full-time YHC student
- Sophomore or above
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- No previous disciplinary record
- No previous Honor Code violations
- Must be in good standing with the college
- Evidence of good character, good judgment, and a commitment to ethical behavior

Responsibilities:

- Attend all training sessions and mandatory meetings
- Actively participate in Student Conduct Council deliberations
- Maintain confidentiality at all times
- Be available for evening hearings
