As part of our comprehensive prevention program for new students, Young Harris College expects you to complete the EverFi AlcoholEdu for College and Haven courses prior to your arrival on campus. We believe these online educational courses will empower you to make well-informed decisions about issues that influence your years at YHC and beyond.

Both of these mandatory courses have two parts. Failure to complete both Part 1 and Part 2 of each course by the deadlines listed below may result in disciplinary action including, but not limited to, a \$50.00 failure to comply fine and an administrative STOP placed on your YHC account. An administrative STOP will prevent you from registering for classes, dropping and/or adding courses, and obtaining a copy of your transcript.

If you have previously completed AlcoholEdu for College or Haven at another institution, you are not required to complete the course(s) again. Please contact me at etwatson@yhc.edu prior to the deadline for Part 1 for information on how to opt out.

The AlcoholEdu for College and Haven courses will be available **beginning Monday, June 19, 2017.**

To register for the courses, please follow the instructions below:

- Go to: <http://www.everfi.com/login> and click "Register"
- Under "Student/Learner," enter the Registration Code: **5a24c6fe** and click "Next" to create your EverFi account
- Enter your YHC email address as your username and choose a password you will remember
 - Note: When prompted, please enter your 9-DIGIT YHC ID NUMBER to receive credit for completing the courses
- Part 1 of both AlcoholEdu for College ***and*** Haven are due by **August 18, 2017**
- On September 18, 2017, you will receive email notification that Part 2 is ready to be completed. Part 2 of both AlcoholEdu for College ***and*** Haven are due **October 6, 2017**

If you already have an EverFi Higher Ed Account, go to <http://www.everfi.com/login>, enter your login information, and then enter the registration code listed above in the "Add a Course" box in the top right corner of the Dashboard.

You will need Internet access and audio capabilities to complete the courses. To avoid technical issues, please use any major web browser (e.g., Firefox, Internet Explorer, Google Chrome) released within the previous two years.

You may take the course in multiple sittings. The course may include surveys to help personalize your experience and measure participants' attitudes and behaviors. All survey responses are confidential; the college will only receive information about the participant group as a whole and will never see individual answers.
