You will receive the HOPE Scholarship listed above if the Georgia Student Finance Commission confirms that you are a 2025-2026 HOPE Scholar. Incoming freshmen must send official high school transcripts to the Georgia Student Finance Commission, 2052 East Exchange Place, Tucker, GA 30084 for evaluation of eligibility. Current students must maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA as calculated by GSPC to maintain eligibility. Your award may be adjusted in the future depending on eligibility and appropriation of funds by the State of Georgia.
